

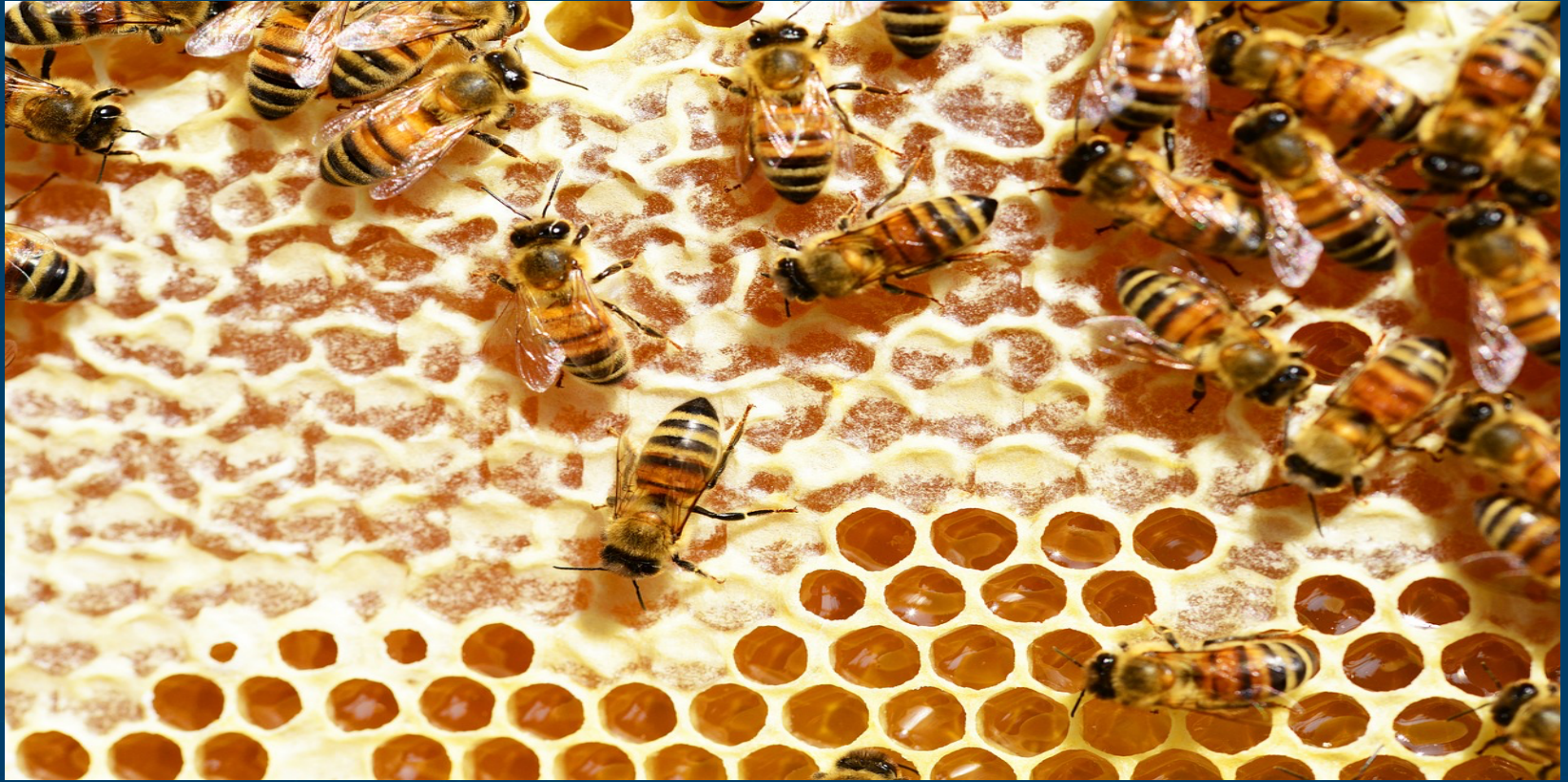

Encounter-level activities to address SDH

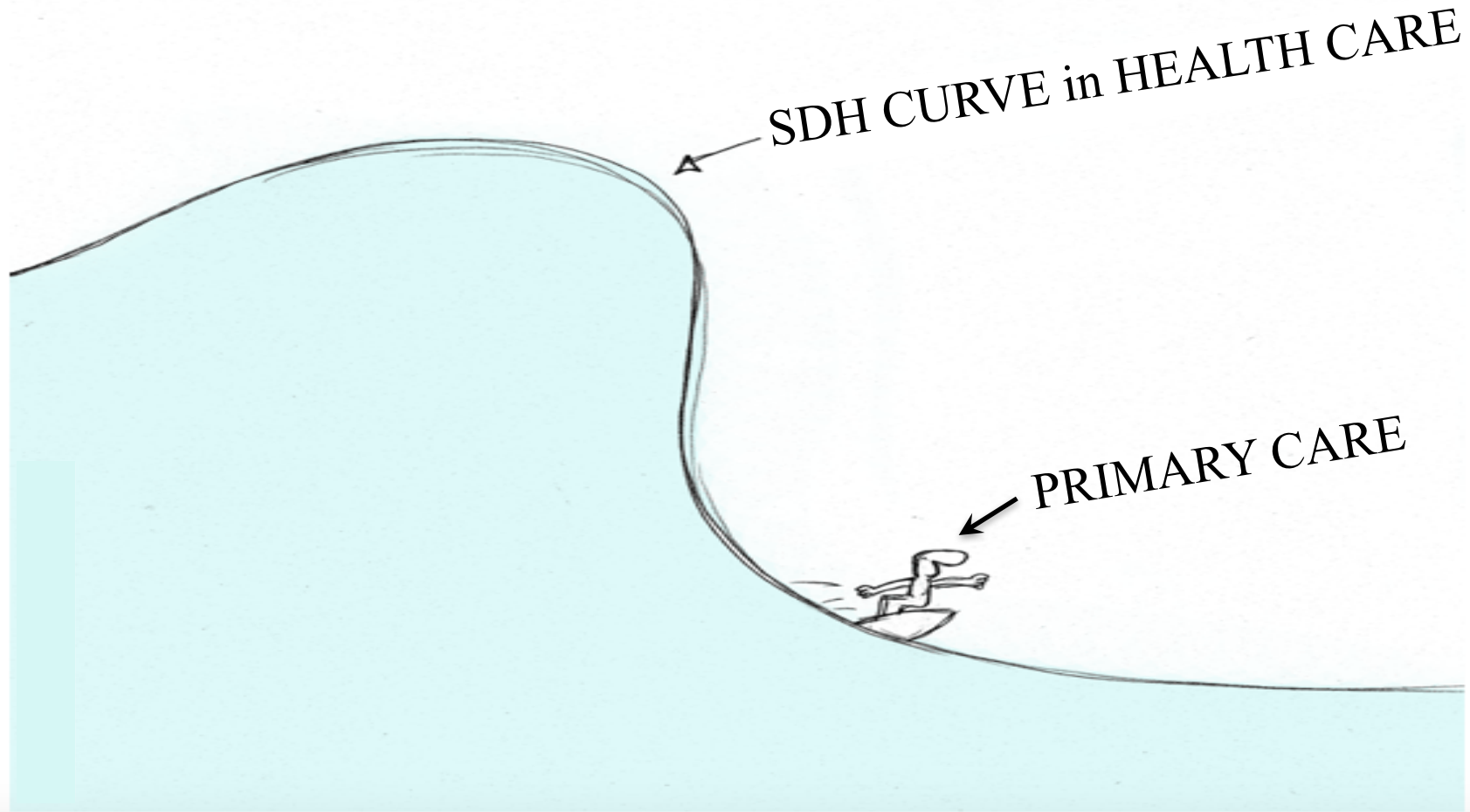
Use SDH data to inform care

Change patients' SDH

- Connect with food programs
- Help obtain and maintain living wage job
- Refer for supportive or low income housing
- Connect with free diaper and parenting programs
- Link to GED or ESL classes

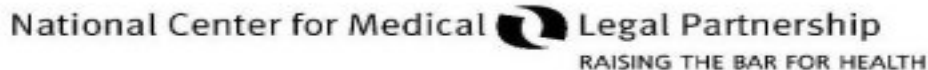


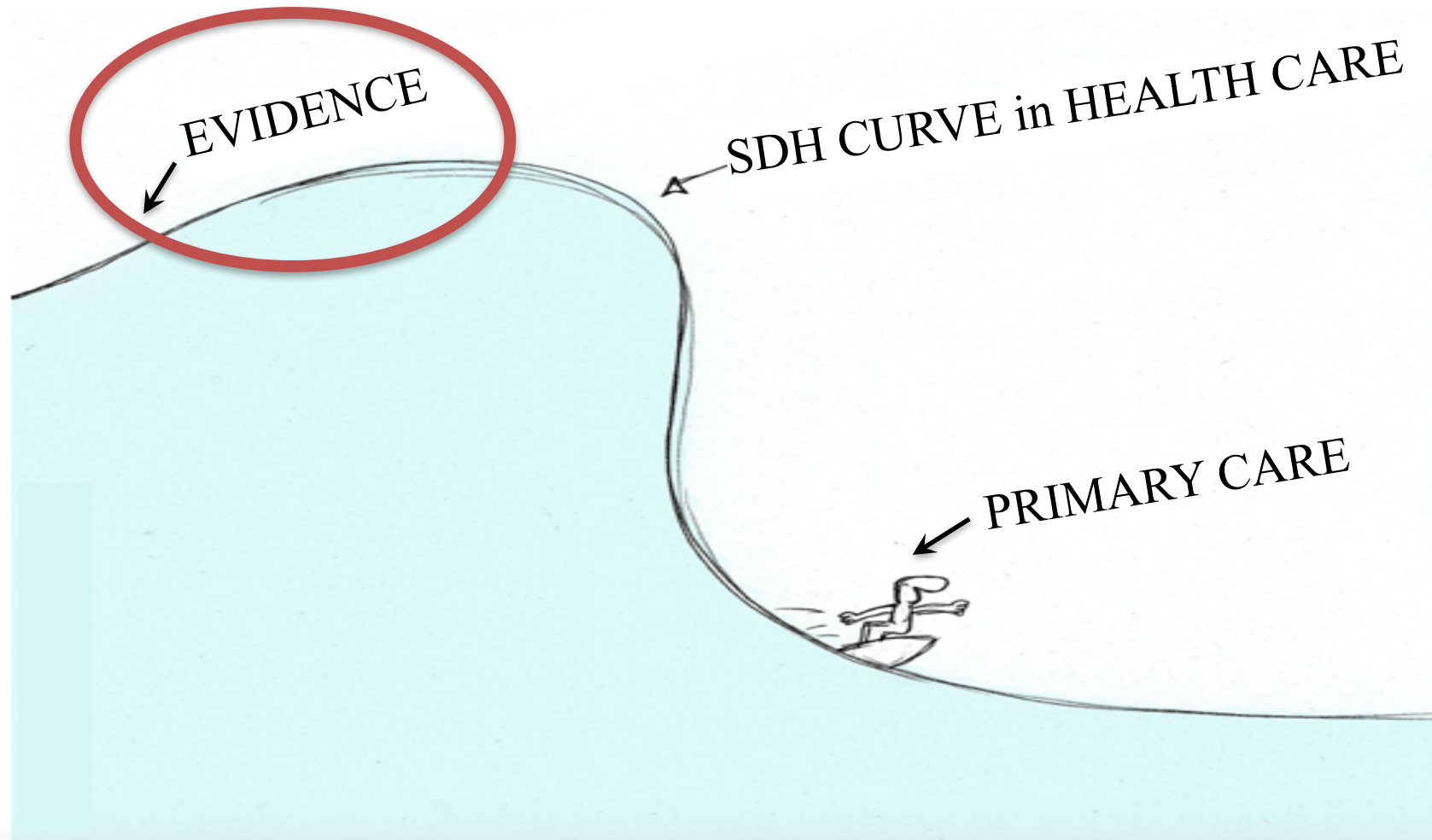


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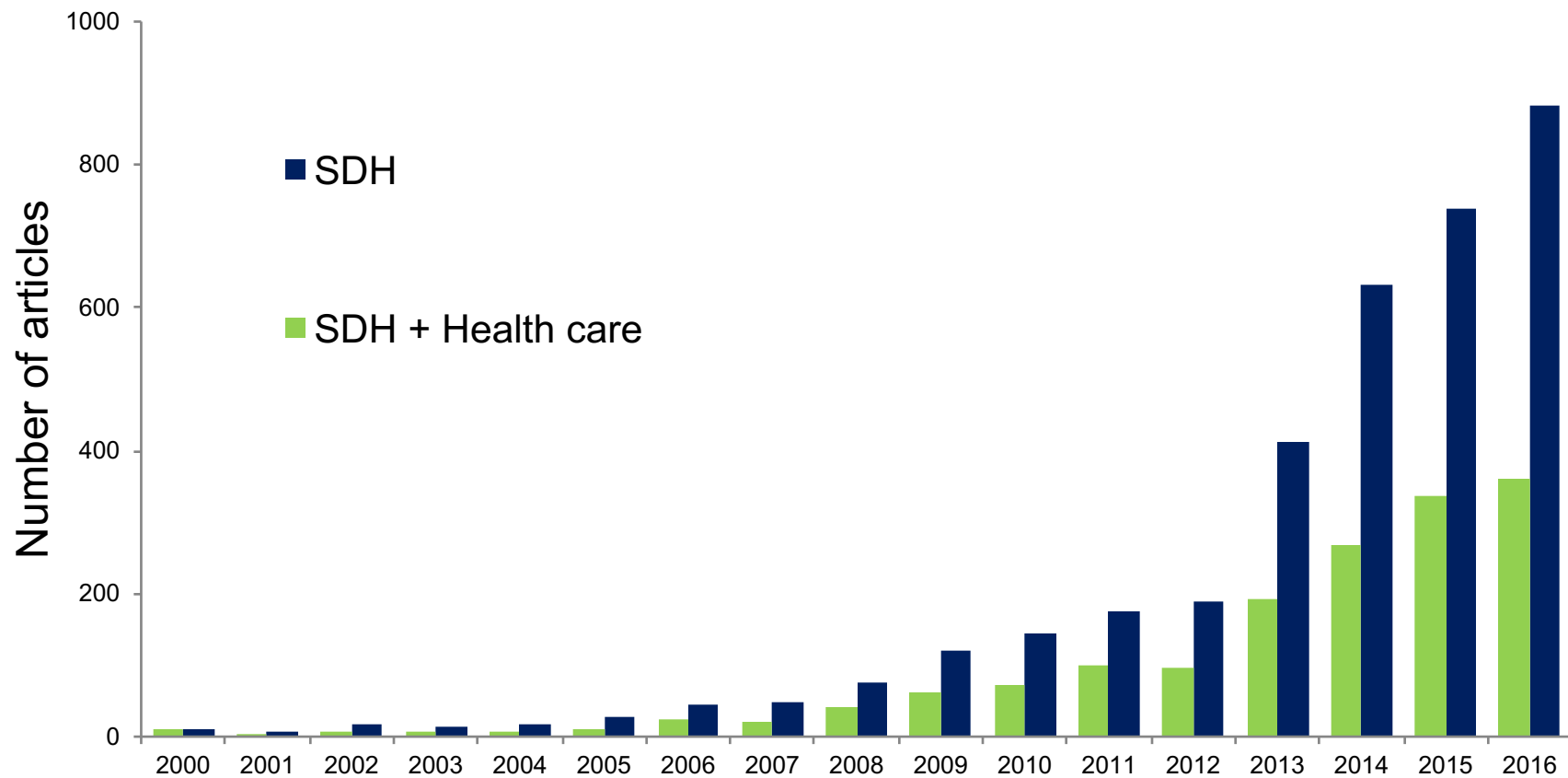

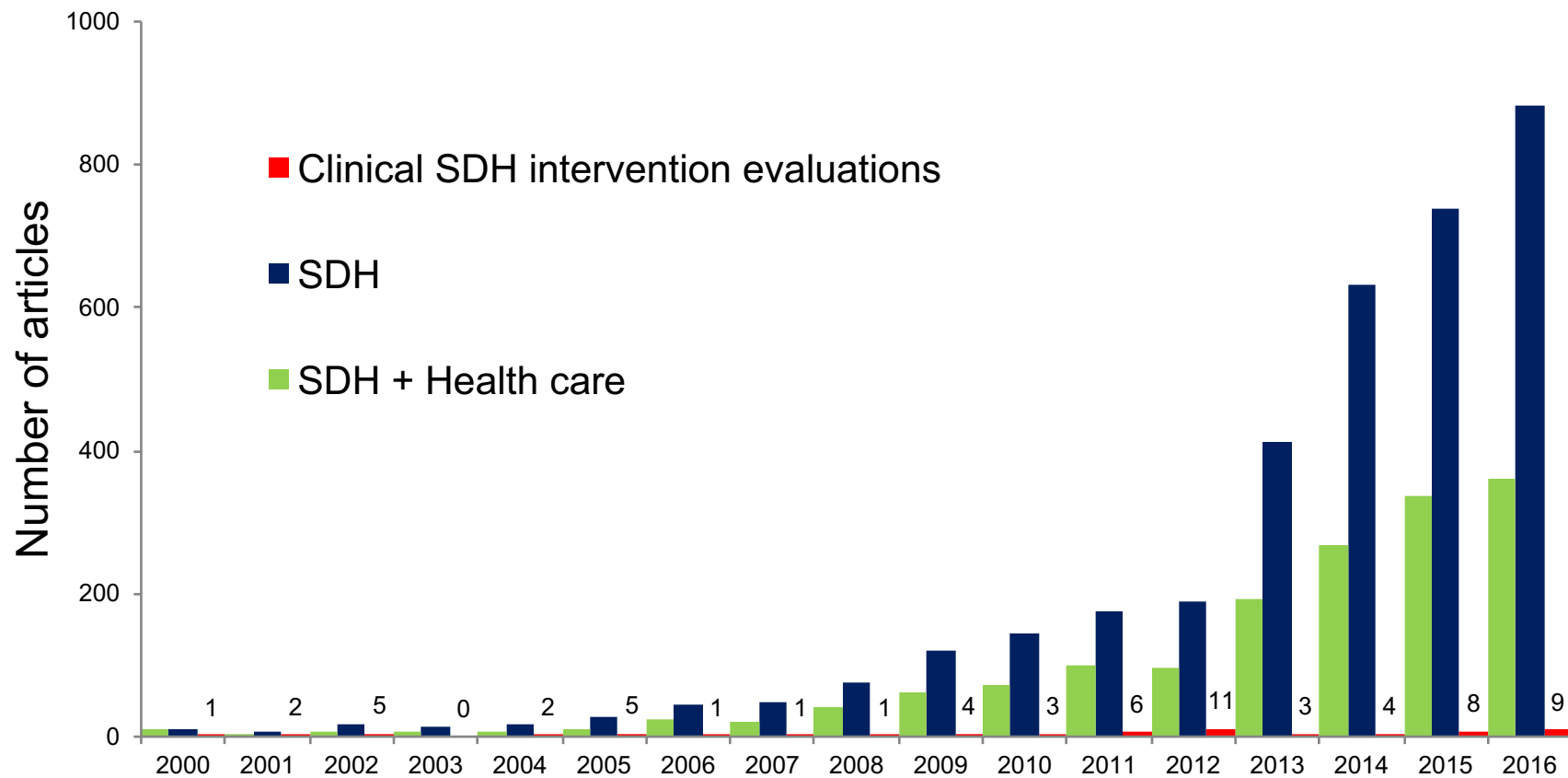


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Increase in SDH Publications, 2000-2015



Minimal change in SDH intervention

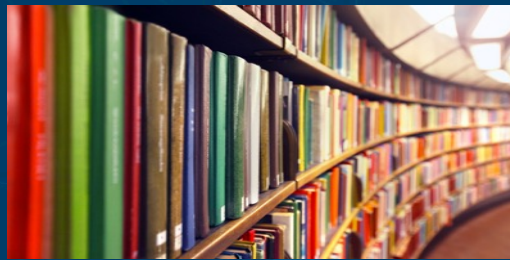
